My training is cross-disciplinary, blending the analytical rigour of American methods - rooted in **Stanislavski's system** - with the physically expressive approach of European theatre. I have studied with masters including: **Meisner, Stella Adler, Uta Hagen, Lee Strasberg** at The American Academy of Dramatic Arts, **Jacques Lecoq** at the *Scuola di Teatro Arsenale*, Milan, experimental physical theatre with **Odin Teatret** (Eugenio Barba) and **PACTA Teatri**, Milan.

These experiences allowed me to explore key roles in classical and contemporary theatre, including: Masha in *The Three Sisters* (Anton Chekhov), Miss Julie in *Miss Julie* (August Strindberg), Eurydice in *Eurydice* (Sarah Ruhl), Mrs. X (monologue) in *The Strongest* (August Strindberg), Martha in *The Children's Hou*r (Lillian Hellman), Catherine in *Proof* (David Auburn).


